- LINUX_REBOOT_MAGIC2A: 0x5121996 — Patricia Miranda's birthday (Linus' first daughter)
- LINUX_REBOOT_MAGIC2B: 0x16041998 — Daniela Yolanda (Linus' second daughter)
- LINUX_REBOOT_MAGIC2C: 0x20112000 — Celeste Amanda (Linus' third daughter)
